



# The New Jersey Marathon Beneficiary Program

## Beneficiary Partner

30+ Volunteers (including a leader)

### **Our beneficiaries are our partners, providing volunteers and other support.**

In order to be considered for inclusion in our Beneficiary Program, a group must be actively involved in our Marathon by:

1. supplying at least thirty (30) volunteers during the three days of the event, and
2. demonstrating that they are actively promoting The New Jersey Marathon events through their own communication channels.

There are a limited number of volunteer positions available each year during The New Jersey Marathon, and any previous beneficiary groups in good standing are offered membership during the upcoming year's event before admitting any new beneficiary groups.

During the summer and fall of the year prior to the next event, all new Beneficiary applicants are added to a wait list, in the order in which they contact us. As soon as the prior year's Beneficiary groups have had a chance to re-apply for the next year's event (by late fall), the wait list groups are contacted, as required, until the total number of volunteers has been reached.

After the event, the official designated beneficiaries share in a sum of money which is determined by the total number of registered participants in our Sunday races.

The money is usually distributed within 90 days of the end of the event and is based upon each individual Beneficiary group's total number of:

- a. volunteers who show up on their assigned day(s) for a complete shift,
- b. volunteers who meet or exceed the expectation of the NJ Marathon staff during their assigned shifts, and
- c. days during which the volunteers are present during the event.
